To support our dedication to sustainability, we have a roadmap which includes Four Key Priorities which underpin our goals:



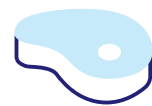

Here is a list of our interim goals on our path toward net zero:

2030

- Water Use: 15% reduction
- Renewable Electricity Use: 60%
- Greenhouse Gas Emissions: 30% reduction
- People Safety: 30% reduction in Safety Index

2040

- Renewable Electricity Use: 100%
- Greenhouse Gas Emissions: Net- Zero across our entire value chain
